SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

<u>All Permits</u>

- A statement of the reason for the requested tree permit.
- Map of the property that diagrams location(s) of each tree requested, including location(s) of nearby utilities.

Street Tree Planting

- A list of each species, and location of the tree(s) proposed to be planted. Proposed tree(s) must be in accordance with City approved street tree list (see attached). If you would like to request consideration of a tree that is not on the approved street tree list, you must have documentation from a certified arborist that the species of tree you wish to plant is equivalent in size, dimensions, and impacts to infrastructure as a tree that is on the approved list for your planter width.
- Tree(s) must comply with spacing requirements from utilities, which is typically 10 feet from water and sewer lines. Spacing requirement from streetlights as well as sight clearances for intersections and traffic control signage must also be met. Sight clearance requirements can be found in the City Development Code.

<u>Note:</u> If it has been determined by the City that a street tree is not compliance with the City Municipal Code it must be removed.

Street Tree Removal

- A list of each species and location of the tree(s) proposed for removal.
- A written recommendation by a licensed tree care professional or ISA certified arborist concerning the health and quality of the tree(s) in question and possible alternative actions (if applicable).

Tree Removal (for trees over 61/2 feet in circumference)

- A list of each species, size, and location of the tree(s) proposed for removal. Circumference is measured at 4½ feet above the junction of the root and trunk sections.
- A written recommendation by a licensed tree care professional or ISA certified arborist concerning the health and quality of the tree(s) in question and possible alternative actions (if applicable).
- A written statement that the tree(s) listed in the application create a unique circumstance, such as:
 - o A tree is causing significant negative impacts to improvements or personal property;
 - o Personal health reasons such as severe allergic conditions;
 - The tree is invasive, having significant negative impact to surrounding vegetation;
 - Removal of the tree is necessary pursuant to a building permit for an improvement for which a site plan approval is not required, and no other feasible alternatives exist for locating the structure.

<u>Note:</u> Unique circumstances may be, but are not guaranteed to be, sufficient reason for approval of tree removal. Approval of tree removal for unique circumstances is at the full discretion of the City.

Heritage Tree Designation Request

- A statement explaining how the tree is significant to the community and why the City Council should designate it as a Heritage Tree.
- Pictures that support the reason for Heritage Tree Designation request. Note: Once a tree is designated as a heritage tree, it will remain so unless it becomes necessary to classify it as a dangerous tree and remove as such. Heritage trees may not be removed without the express consent of the City Council.
