

Rules of Conduct for Public Hearings

- 1. No person shall be disorderly, abusive, or disruptive of the orderly conduct of the hearing.
- Persons shall not testify without first receiving recognition from the presiding officer and stating their full name and residence address.
- 3. No person shall present irrelevant, immaterial, or repetitious testimony or evidence.
- 4. There shall be no audience demonstrations such as applause, cheering, display of signs, or other conduct disruptive of the hearing.
