RESOLUTION NO. 2021-14

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH CH2M HILL, INC. REGARDING CLAIMS RELATED TO A WASTEWATER TREATMENT TECHNOLOGY

WHEREAS, Albany filed claims against CH2M HILL, Inc. arising from a wastewater treatment technology in Linn County Circuit Court Case No. 17CV53215; and,

WHEREAS, Millersburg is a joint owner with Albany in the wastewater treatment facility involved with the wastewater treatment technology; and,

WHEREAS, Millersburg has joined Albany in Linn County Circuit Court Case No. 17CV53215; and,

WHEREAS, Albany, Millersburg, and CH2M HILL, Inc. have conceptually agreed to a settlement of all claims related to a wastewater treatment technology; and,

WHEREAS, the Millersburg City Council believes it is in the citizens' best interest to enter into a Settlement Agreement to be prepared by the City's attorneys.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Millersburg City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Settlement Agreement prepared by the City's attorneys related to the settlement of all claims regarding the wastewater treatment technology.
