D. BUDGET UPDATE:

Sheena reported we paid \$500 to Kona Ice, \$348 for Mom's magazine ad, and \$273.35 to Destination Events for Drone Show and Family Fun Day events.

E. OLD BUSINESS

a. July 25 Drone Show: No advertisers for this year but have ideas for next year. (Timberlab and Millersburg-Ryan's Custom Signs) Michele went to Les Schwab about popcorn and they don't lend out their machine, but the Party Store will rent one for \$68 a day with 50 percent off on boxes of popcorn. Popcorn can be secured over the phone. Michele will ask if Les Schwab would donate popcorn. We could serve it on both days (Drone Show and Family Day). We would also provide water. 10 cases at about \$8 a case with a total of around \$220. We will have to provide garbage cans-Dick or city staff will handle this. Volunteers would need to replace bags each hour-4.

The flyer will say, "Popcorn w/Drone Show and music" or something to that effect.

b. Family Day in the Park: July 27th from 1:00 pm-5:00 pm

Activities: Bounce House, Basketball Shoot, Face Painting & Balloon Art, Altrusa (books), three-legged race, gunny sack race, balloon toss (with reusables), pinatas twice (different times for different ages), set out rocks to paint, friendship bracelets, and donut on a string. Cornhole could be a good game for older folks. (signs on poster boards or white boards)

- Pinata at 2:00 p.m. (ages 2-6) and 4:00 p.m. (ages 7-12) and another (ages 13 plus). Will need three pinatas and needing three volunteer's total.
- Three-legged race at 1:15 p.m., 1:45 p.m., gunny sack races at 2:15 p.m., 2:45 p.m. and so on. Will need four volunteers, one for each hour-long section of time, 1-2 p.m., 2-3 p.m., 3-4 p.m., and 4-5 p.m.)
- Balloon toss at same time as three-legged and donut on a string at the same time as gunny sack race (Michele will figure out logistics) (four volunteers, each for one hour as above)
- Ongoing events: Bounce House (four volunteers-one per hour), Basketball Shoot, cornhole, face-painting and balloon art, Altrusa (?), paint your own rocks and make friendship bracelets.

Costco has reusable balloons. Water, balloons, and candy for pinata will be bought by Sheena at Costco.

Dick will ask around to see about people coming to teach cornhole.
